

TEC-SMART Job Fair

Hudson Valley Community College is searching for adjunct professors to teach at its new facility located in Malta, NY. The facility will open in January 2010 and an information session about the positions available will be held on **September 16 from 4 – 6 p.m.** The information session will take place at 107 Hermes in the Saratoga Technology and Energy Park[®] (STEP[®]) adjacent to the site of Hudson Valley's new facility.
